

He is the Chairman for Center for Reform and Development Inc. which promotes cultural reform for the development of Filipino youth and supports a balanced national development that gives equal opportunities for Filipinos.

He co-Chairs the Supervisory Board for Center for Trade and Technology, a Russian-based online platform for assessing, promoting and transferring domestic technologies to the Asia-Pacific region, thereby enabling Russian companies to establish partnership with Asian companies.

As Chairman of Istana Social Development Foundation Inc, he promotes literacy among underprivileged but deserving individuals by granting scholarships, donating school buildings and supporting community-based enterprises in rural areas such as medical missions and livelihood programs.

As Chairman for the Philippine Business Conference and Expo 2015, he helps position Philippine capitalists and enterprises to gain foothold in the ASEAN and global markets and capture investments coming into the region.

He is also Chairman Emeritus of Athena e-Services, a technology company involved in electronic publishing, litigation support, financial research for Fortune 500 companies in the United States and other countries.
